

Requirements for becoming an Internet e-mail notice recipient:

- ' Have an e-mail provider that is DSN-compliant. DSN (Delivery Status Notification) provides confirmation that the e-mail sent by the BNC was delivered to your mailbox. DSN is required in order to comply with Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 9036, and provides assurance to you and the court that notices were successfully delivered. To see a list of DSN-compliant e-mail providers, or to have your current e-mail tested for DSN compliance, please visit the BNC web site at www.ebnuscourts.com, or call their toll free support number at 877-837-3424.
- ' Have Adobe Acrobat Reader software version 4.0 or higher installed on the PC you will access the e-mail from. If you do not have this software, you can download it free of charge from www.adobe.com/prodindex/acrobat/readstep.html.
- ' Sign a Noticing Agreement. To see a list of courts currently participating in EBN, which services are offered and which Noticing Agreement to sign, please visit the BNC web site at www.ebnuscourts.com, or call their toll free support number at 877-837-3424.
