



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**STANDING ORDER**

This matter came before the Court on the motion of the standing Chapter 13 trustee for a Standing Order in the District of Maine authorizing and directing the payment of the costs and expenses of recording a copy of the debtor's Chapter 13 petition in cases involving real estate in the appropriate Registries of Deeds. After notice and hearing and for good cause shown, the trustee's motion is granted. It is hereby ORDERED that the standing Chapter 13 trustee shall pay the costs and expenses of recording an attested a copy of the debtor's Chapter 13 petition in the Registry of Deeds for the county in which the debtor owns real estate as an administrative expense from the funds of each individual debtor's estate. No commission for expense allowance shall be taken by the standing Chapter 13 trustee for such disbursements.
