RULE 7008-1 - CORE/NON-CORE DESIGNATION (COMPLAINT) [RESERVED]

The requirement to plead jurisdiction specifically extends to any pleading which sets forth a claim for relief, whether by complaint, counterclaim, cross-claim or third-party claim, unless the claim for relief is clearly within the bounds of the controversy over which the Court already has jurisdiction. The jurisdictional allegations shall specifically designate the claim(s) for relief as core or non-core matter(s). As to non-core matters, the complaint must expressly state whether or not the plaintiff consents to entry of final order or judgment by the Bankruptcy Judge.
